NEXT STEPS

1. Attend an Information Sharing and Project Design Workshop

Once we receive your expression of interest you will be invited to an Information Sharing and Project Design Workshop where you will be provided with more information on the grant scheme and how to develop a proposal.

Attending an Information Sharing and Project Design Workshop is compulsory. Workshops will be conducted over a 2 week period between Saturday 5 June and Saturday 20 June 2021. We will contact you to advise when and where the Workshops will be held.

2. Submit a proposal

A call for proposals will be advertised in June. To proceed to the proposal stage of the Grants you will need to have evidence of the following OR partner with an organisation which does:

1. You are a citizen or a legal entity of one of the Pacific ACP countries.
 2. You have been established for:
 - at least 3 years in one Pacific ACP Member State? (Small and medium grants)
 - at least 6 years in one Pacific ACP Member State? (Large grants)
 3. You have prior experience of implementing a community project.
 4. Since 2018 you:
 - have you directly implemented at least one project in the cultural and creative sector with a value of at least 50% of the amount of the grant you are requesting through this EOI.
- OR**
- are you able to demonstrate an annual turnover equivalent to the value of 50% of the amount of the grant you are requesting through this EOI.
5. You will be directly responsible for the preparation and management of the activities being funded.

REMEMBER ... *if you don't meet some of the criteria above think about partnering with someone else or an organisation which does.*
